16/095 16/095/1	County Councillor's Report: Oxfordshire County Council cut the grass outside The Manor House, Barford St Michael. The Chairman had received a complaint from the owner that it should not be cut.

Minor patching and raising of the sunken drain in Lower Street were agreed. Roads may have to be closed which will delay the start for 12 weeks. 16/096 16/096/1	District Councillor's Report: A361 Working Group - District Cllrs Bryn Williams and Hugo Brown have set up a working group to investigate with OCC Highways the ongoing issues with the A361. These are numerous and affect South Newington, Bloxham, Banbury, Burford and Chipping Norton where ever increasing numbers of vehicles and HGV's are making life a misery for residents. Opinions will be sought from residents, businesses and users of the A361 and solutions explored with OCC.
